

Cost of Study in Hong Kong



- Eligible for the Right of Abode after residing in HK for a continuous period of > 7 years




Undergraduate Programme Structure

5-year Educational Programmes (156 cps)



Upon completion of the Bachelor of Education programme, graduates may register with the Education Bureau of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government as a <u>qualified teacher</u> and teach in kindergartens, primary schools or secondary schools.

4-year Programmes (121 cps)



Students who wish to obtain teacher qualifications in Hong Kong without a Bachelor of Education degree must obtain a Postgraduate Diploma in Education.




EdUHK Entrance Scholarship Scheme

(Above scholarships are renewable annually subject to satisfactory performance)




Application Procedures
